Spellings: Spellings will be given out on a Friday and be tested the following Friday. They will be linked to a spelling rule that has been learnt that week or to the words that have to be learnt as detailed in the National Curriculum.

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As writers, this term we will be exploring a fiction text called 'Stone Age Boy' by Satoshi Kitamura. From this we will be writing a finding tale, where a main character finds something unusual and it causes a problem.

As athletes, this term we will be dancing.

As philosophers, this term we will be exploring a unit all on 'celebrating differences'.

As historians, this term we will be answering the question 'Would you prefer to have lived in the Stone Age, Bronze Age or Iron Age?'

As computerists, this term we will be exploring digital photography. We will look at different devices that can capture images and how we can improve photos.
