Y4 MULTIPLICATION CHECK

Year 4 multiplication check

This is a Statutory Government check to determine whether your child can fluently recall their times tables up to 12, which is essential for future success in mathematics. It will also help your child's school to identify if your child may need additional support.

What is the multiplication check?

It is an on screen check consisting of 25 times table questions. Your child will be able to answer 3 practice questions before taking the actual check. They will then have 6 seconds to answer each question. On average, the check should take no longer than 5 minutes.

What if my child cannot access the check?

There are several access arrangements available for the check, which can be used to support specific needs. Your teacher will ensure that these access arrangements are appropriate before they take the test in June.

What support can I provide?

Constant practice of the times tables facts would be really helpful. Ensuring children use their TT Rockstars account 'sound check' to practice the multiplication facts they find tricky.

We will be doing practice screenings with the children in school to help prepare them.

How will I know the result?

Schools will have access to the results the week after the testing period ends. This will be communicated in the children's end of year report and used to support pupils moving in lessons. There is no pass or fail mark for the check.

Testing period- Mon 2nd June to Friday 13th June.
